Transportation to Texas A&M University from Corpus Christi International Airport

Corpus Christi International Airport is approximately 25 km (16 miles) from the Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi campus. It will take you about 20 minutes to travel from the airport to the campus.

The easiest *and* most convenient way to get from the airport to campus is via TAXI. All Taxi companies in Corpus Christi are inexpensive, charge a similar amount (depending on the distance traveled) and are metered.

Airport taxis are all located on level 1 (ground floor) of the airport (your arrival gate will be on level 2). Upon arrival, proceed to baggage claim (level 1) and after claiming your luggage go to the street level entrance and look for the TAXI sign and wait your turn.

If you are going to TAMU-CC Campus Housing tell the Taxi driver to take you to Texas A&M University Corpus Christi student housing. We have two university housing properties to meet your needs. Both properties are available to any enrolled student: <http://housing.tamucc.edu/> The normal hours of operation for residence hall check-in is 9AM – 10PM Monday through Friday, and 10AM – 8PM on Saturday and Sunday.

The taxi fare to campus housing will be approximately \$50 (including tip) and up to six (6) individuals may ride in the same vehicle if a van is requested at the time of hire. The taxi fare to off campus apartments and similar destinations within the greater Corpus Christi area will be similar.

Students who have either an international or U.S. (state) driver's license, passport and are at least 21 years of age may also rent a car at the airport (the rental car kiosks are located immediately in front of baggage claim). The approximate charge for a compact car, including insurance coverage, is \$75 per day.
